E Diesel

E-Diesel, one of the UK's first genuinely sustainable biofuel products, has been in commercial production for around a decade. It is manufactured entirely from recycled vegetable and marine oils.

Produced in the UK to the exacting parameters of BS EN 14214, E-Diesel creates no net carbon dioxide emissions and burns much more cleanly and efficiently than fossil diesel.

A commercial alternative to petroleum diesel fuel, e-diesel offers similar performance and fuel economy to petroleum diesel and is comparable in price. However, with no sulphur content and a 100% reduction in carbon dioxide, it dramatically reduces greenhouse gas contribution.

E-Diesel is suitable for both traditional and modern common rail diesel engines and, depending on whether it is used pure or as a blend with ultra low sulphur diesel, it has been approved for use by most European vehicle manufacturers. However we would always recommend checking warranty arrangements with specific manufacturers before use, as some vehicles will be out of warranty if using high biodiesel blends.
